DESTINATION: DISCOVERY WORLD ON MARKET

This Spring, the world comes to Parkersburg with the opening of Discovery World on Market, a new children's museum in the heart of downtown. Discovery World on Market is designed primarily for little learners ages 0-10 with a focus on playing and growing together with family and friends.

From the original kid-friendly rhymes on the walls to hands-on STEAM activities, families, school groups and more can spend the day interacting with exhibits that stir the senses and ignite the imagination.

In the **River Adventure**, visitors will uncover the wild and wonderful nature of the Ohio River, its crucial role in shaping our community, and the many animals and plants who call our area home. Water play stations kids love (and smocks, dryers and changing areas families need) bring joy to learning about experimenting with everything from cause and effect to the power of water.

At **The Ball Factory**, visitors work together towards common goals by emphasizing communication, collaboration, and community. A whimsical central climbing structure is surrounded by ball-driven kinetic contraptions and activities, drawing inspiration from factory processes and Parkersburg's important and fascinating industrial history.



In the **Design Studio**, visitors explore making and problem-solving with a variety of materials. Experimentation and design-thinking are championed through making and problem-solving stations that guide young visitors through creative and technical processes, inspiring kids to dream big and imagine themselves as the scientists, engineers and artists of the future.

ISLAND OF INTRIGUE

A grove of towering black walnut trees, twittering songbirds, and an air of opulent serenity greet visitors as they step onto Blennerhassett Island — a serene 500-acre destination in the middle of the Ohio River with a dramatic history. And while only an easy 20-minute sternwheel boat ride away, visitors will feel transported back in time to the early 19th century as they tour the meticulously re-created Blennerhassett mansion, take a horse-drawn wagon ride, and hear tales from the staff who share their tales in period-accurate clothing.

THE BLENNERHASSETTS, AARON BURR, AND AN ISLAND OF INTRIGUE.

Harman Blennerhassett and his wife, Margaret, settled on what was then known as Backus Island in 1798 after purchasing a portion of it from Elijah Backus; they soon constructed an enormous estate. At the time of its completion, the Palladian mansion was the largest and grandest in what was then the American West. The Blennerhassetts were Irish aristocrats who lived a luxurious lifestyle and hosted lavish gatherings at their home.

Aaron Burr, U.S. vice president to Thomas Jefferson, became close friends with Harman Blennerhassett after Burr shot and killed Alexander Hamilton in their famous duel. Blennerhassett allowed Burr use of his island paradise as a base of operations for his scandalous plans to establish a southwestern empire. Eventually, their plot allegedly grew treasonous: to raise a militia, separate the Louisiana Territory from the American Union and establish a new country. President Jefferson soon got word from concerned local citizens and sent the Virginia militia to overtake the insurrection's headquarters on Blennerhassett Island. Burr was arrested and the Blennerhassetts were forced to


relinquish their property, their home, and all of their belongings. Their grand estate burned to the ground in 1811, destroying most of the family's possessions.

Long after Harman's death, the government eventually returned the property to Margaret Blennerhassett, by then living in poverty in New York, after she won a case in the Supreme Court. Fatefully, Margaret and one of their children returned to the island only after death; their bodies were relocated in 1996 to the gardens behind the recreation of the Blennerhassett House, which was built in the 1980s in the likeness of the original.

EXPLORE AMERICA'S FIRST FRONTIER

The Ohio River Valley was America's first frontier, the country's original Wild, Wild, West. Here, you don't just hear about history: from historic mansions, homes and hotels to faithful recreations and tours, American history comes to life in Greater Parkersburg.

Take a ride on our authentic sternwheel boat, **Island Belle**, across the Ohio River to **Blennerhassett Island** — a land stuck in time with a dramatic past and scandalous backstory. Before setting off on your (brief and comfortable) voyage, stop by the **Blennerhassett Museum of Regional History** to peruse local artifacts and purchase tickets for the sternwheel ride to the Island, including a mansion tour and horse-drawn wagon ride.

Explore the ornate architectural details of the Victorian-era homes with a self-guided walking tour of the **Julia-Ann Square Historic District**, the largest and oldest historic district in West Virginia.

Enjoy a short sternwheeler ride down the Ohio River from Marietta, Ohio and board a trolley for the short ride to **Henderson Hall** – a perfect day trip. Built in 1859 as the centerpiece of the 2,600 acre plantation, Henderson Hall is a fascinating piece of history touching topics as diverse as Native American history, elections, founding fathers, slavery, treason and education; the home contains an incredible collection of interesting historical artifacts and ephemera saved by the five generations who lived there.

Breathe in the breathtaking view of the Ohio River Valley at **Fort Boreman Historical Park**, a hill with a history dating back to

the Civil War. Cross the river into Marietta to tour the **Campus Martius Museum** and soak up more than 200 years of history focused on the Northwest Territory, including its oldest remaining structures and the **Ohio Company Land Office**. While in Marietta, visit **The Castle** — an impressive Gothic Revival house built in 1855. Uncover hidden gems of Appalachian history at the nationally recognized **Oil and Gas Museum**, and learn how oil and gas impacted West Virginia's statehood. After all that adventuring, stay awhile at the stately **Blennerhassett Hotel** in Parkersburg, with its own past dating back more than a century. The hotel has stayed true to its original glory through recent renovations, with a beautiful interior decor, inviting facade, and signature on-site restaurant and bar offering a casual yet elegant atmosphere.

GET OUTSIDE

Witness the beautiful and earthly splendor of the great outdoors in Greater Parkersburg with outdoor adventure activities for the entire family, including hiking, kayaking, ATV trails, and mountain biking.

HIKING

At **North Bend State Park**, hikers can explore 17 hiking trails stretching over 26 miles, ranging from beginner to expert. The 277-acre **McDonough Wildlife Refuge** features sightings of West Virginia wildlife including white-tailed deer, turkey, red and gray foxes, and coyote along its clearly marked trails. Hiking, biking, ATV driving, camping, bird-watching, fishing, boating, and more can be found at **Mountwood Park**, which lives up to its slogan: "something for everyone."

KAYAKING

Grab your paddle and hit the water for scenic kayaking in Parkersburg that the whole family can enjoy. The **Ohio River Water Trail** offers kayakers 39 miles on the Ohio River and 18 miles on the Little Kanawha River. The Little Kanawha is a hidden gem, offering gentle and flat currents for paddlers of all kinds. In addition to great kayaking, the Little Kanawha is a fantastic spot for people looking to catch musky and smallmouth bass. The 305-acre, 8.1-mile lake at **North Bend State Park** is a perfect destination for kayakers to enjoy the serenity and beauty of West Virginia at its best.

ATV TRAILS

Mountwood Park's newest trail system consists of professionally designed ATV trails for four wheelers, side by sides, and motorcycles. Trail levels range from easy to difficult, with most being in the moderate range. The trails are open year-round during daylight hours.









STOKED FOR SPOKES With 225+ miles of single-track trails and 72 miles of rail-trail to explore, Greater Parkersburg is a hot spot for mountain enthusiasts.

biking and bicycle riding in general. Experienced and novice bikers alike can find trails with a suitable difficulty. These biking venues, less than 30 minutes apart, have made the area one of West Virginia's hottest destinations for biking

Known for its mountainous scenery, the North Bend Rail-**Trail** offers easy riding across the length of north-central West Virginia, taking riders on a journey over 36 bridges and through 10 scenic tunnels. A part of the American Discovery Trail, the low grades are perfect for a laid-back bike ride with the family.

Adjacent to the North Bend Rail Trail, North Bend State Park features a challenging 20-mile single track that surrounds the park's lake, campgrounds, and lodge. Just minutes from North Bend State Park, mountain bikers can also find thrilling rides at top-rated, 2,000-acre Mountwood Park, with 35 miles of flowing trails surrounding a pristine lake. The park's new machine-made Flow Trail creates a rhythmic riding experience for riders of all skill levels.

Across the river in Marietta, Ohio, bicyclists can venture to the Marietta City Trail Network, connecting more than 30 miles



of trail to the town's historic downtown area. Rugged trails can be found at Wayne National Forest — with 80 miles of trail on 64,000 acres, challenge yourself with a single or multiday ride. The Broughton Nature and Wildlife Education Area offers 875 acres of outdoor space, including mountain biking.

- > Turn right at Rt. 800 to Ohio 7 South
- At Fly, take the Sistersville Ferry and cross the Ohio River
- > Travel Rt. 2 South to I-77
- Make a right onto I-77 North and Exit at 185 WV Welcome Center

- Turn left onto Rt. 124 South toward Pomeroy, OH
- > Ride through Pomeroy and cross bridge into WV
- Turn left onto Route 62 for 17 miles to Rt. 2 North toward Ravenswood
- At Ravenswood turn left onto Rt. 68 and travel through Ravenswood
- Take US Rt. 50 East toward Parkersburg, WV
- Take I-77 North to Exit 185 WV Welcome Center



- > Turn left toward Pennsboro, WV
- Take a right to Rt. 50 West
- Turn right toward Ellenboro, WV
- > Take Rt. 16 North to St. Marys, WV
- Take Rt. 2 South to I-77 North
- Take I-77 to Exit 185 WV Welcome Center
